## Home Energy Makeover Workshop & Expo

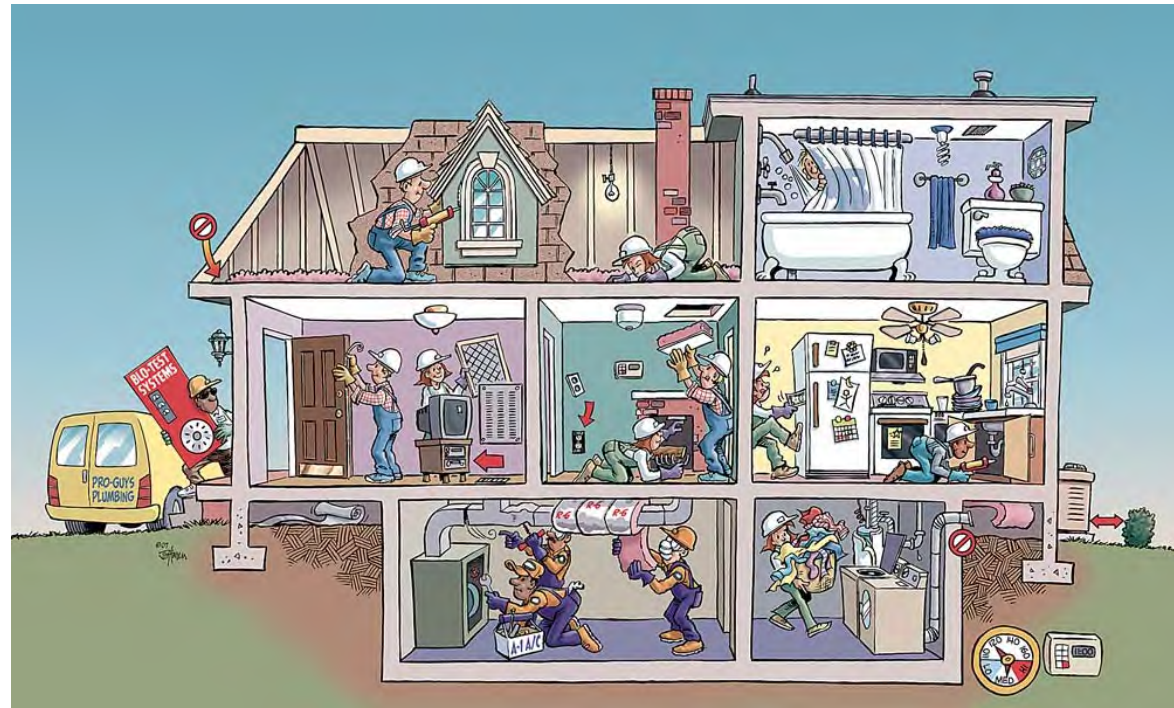
